

Live Online Proctoring FAQs

- 1. Are bathroom breaks allowed?

 Candidates are allowed one (1) bathroom break during the three (3) hour testing window, however excessive time away during this break may result in the proctor invalidating the exam.
- Can handheld calculators or cellphones be used during the exam?
 No handheld calculators or cellphones are permitted during the exam. The exam provides a built-in calculator for the candidates use.
- Can the candidate use scratch paper during the exam?
 Candidates can use a clean white board or blank scratch paper during the exam. The proctor will verify that the paper is blank at the beginning of the exam.
